

DRESS CODE

Uniforms

This applies to students in grades one through eight.

SHIRTS: Boys and girls may wear plain light blue or white shirts, long or short sleeve, collared or turtleneck, oxford, cloth or knit. No ruffles, piping or embroidery - including insignias - will be allowed. Form-fitting, abbreviated length shirts will not be allowed. T shirts worn under uniform tops must be plain white to prevent colors from showing through uniform shirts. Shirts must be tucked into pants, shorts, or skirts.

SWEATERS: Navy blue, hunter green, or white in V-neck, pull-over, or cardigan.

PANTS: Boys and girls may wear navy slacks. Junior high students (Grades 7 & 8) may wear navy or khaki slacks. Standard waist-line pants with blue, black, or brown belts. Low-cut “hip-hugger” pants, leggings, crop pants, stirrup pants, or any style warm-up pants will not be allowed.

SKIRTS, JUMPERS, SKORTS: Any style navy blue or the uniform plaid provided by the uniform company. Skirts, jumpers, skorts must be appropriate length.

SOCKS: White or dark for boys. White or navy anklets, knee socks or tights for girls. Socks must be worn at all times.

SHOES: Dress or athletic shoes are both acceptable. Tennis shoes are to be worn for gym classes. Sandals may be worn if they have a strap across the heel. No flip-flops or clogs may be worn.

WALKING SHORTS: Navy blue walking shorts may be worn. Junior high students (Grades 7 & 8) may wear khaki walking shorts.

The shirts, blouses, sweaters, navy skirts, jumpers, skorts, slacks, and shorts may be purchased anywhere. Only the plaid items need to be purchased from the uniform company. No other plaids allowed.

Kindergarten students are not required to wear uniforms. Kindergarten students are expected to dress in a manner that is neat, clean, and appropriate for school.

Should a student come to school dressed inappropriately, parents will be called to bring appropriate clothing for the student.
